Compare bathroom remodel quotes line by line so you can tell a fair price from a padded one.



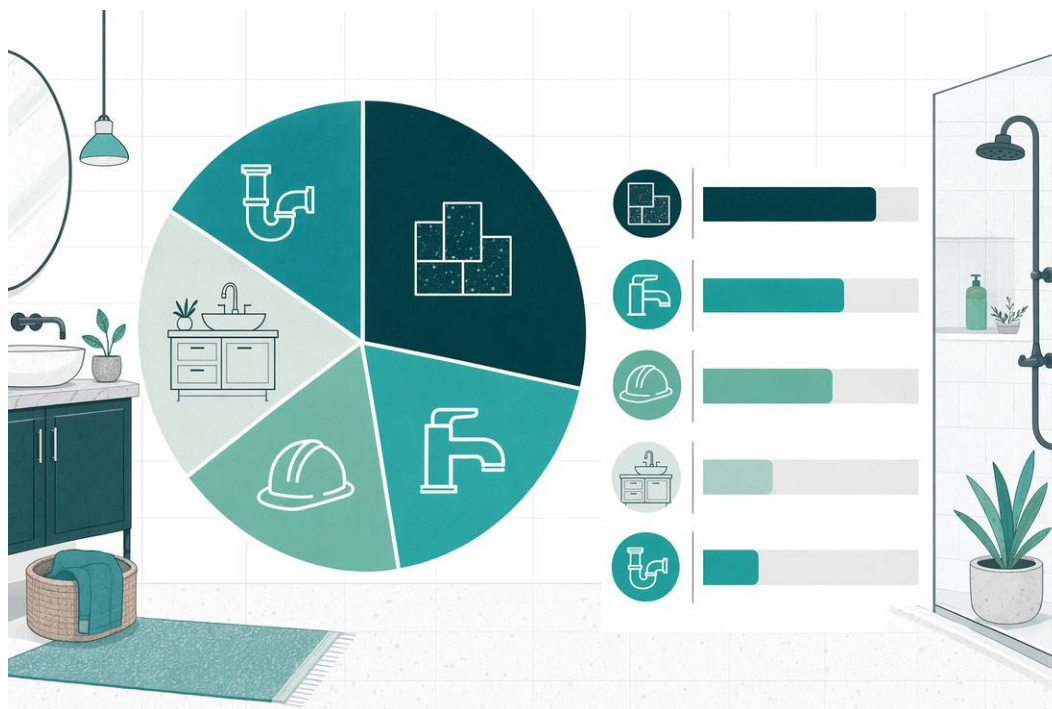
Plan your bathroom remodel with open eyes — then get matched, free, with licensed, insured remodelers near you. You compare quotes and choose who to hire.

Why the cheapest quote is rarely the real bill

Two quotes for 'a bathroom' can mean two very different projects. The gap is usually in what's left out — and skipped waterproofing is the most expensive thing to leave out. Compare like for like.

Line items to line up side by side

- Demolition and disposal
- Waterproofing system (named, not assumed)
- Tile (type, square footage, and labor)
- Shower or tub, glass, and the valve
- Vanity, countertop, sink, and fixtures (who supplies them)
- Plumbing and electrical work, ventilation fan
- Permits, inspections, and cleanup



Questions that reveal the truth

- 1 What is NOT included in this number?
- 2 What waterproofing system is used behind the tile?
- 3 Is the permit cost inside or outside the quote?
- 4 What grade of tile and fixtures is assumed?
- 5 What happens to the price if there's hidden moisture damage?

Score each quote

For each contractor, mark whether every line above is included, excluded, or unclear. The most complete quote — not the lowest — is usually the honest one.
